Bethany Day Care/Kindergarten/Preschool Center is a ministry of Bethany Bible Church and is an integral part of this organization. It is our intent to glorify God in the care and training we provide for children. Our program includes Bible stories, songs, and videos designed to promote good character qualities.

OUR DAILY SCHEDULE IS AS FOLLOWS:

6:00am – 9:00am	Children Arrive – quiet activities and table games. School-age children leave for elementary school.
9:00am – 12:00pm	Preschool Program – a structured, teacher directed time of Bible stories, music, crafts, finger plays, action poems, movement activities and large muscle play in a planned theme or unit of study. <u>Breakfast is provided.</u>
9:00am – 12:00pm	Kindergarten Program
12:00pm – 1:00pm	Lunch (Parent Provided) Clean Up, Gym Time, Prepare for Naps
12:45pm – 3:00pm	K4 Preschool Program – this meets Monday, Wednesday and Friday during the school year. Rest and quiet time for full-day children.
3:00pm – 6:00pm	Afternoon snack , self-directed play (indoor or outdoor weather permitted).

Please bring your child **INTO THE BUILDING** through the main entrance, help remove and hang up coats and take them to their teacher. When bringing or picking up your child, please sign the attendance sheet. Preschool parents, please wait in the foyer area for the teachers to bring your child to you at 12:00pm or 2:45pm.

A child cannot be released to anyone except his parent or guardian unless we have been notified in advance. Be sure to also notify us if you do not intend to pick up your child at the usual time.

Each preschool child must have a CHANGE OF CLOTHES on hand at the Day Care. Also, for full-day children, please send along a small blanket and pillow for rest time. Blankets should be taken home to be laundered each weekend. We will charge a \$3.00 fee if we need to wash them. Please be sure all items (including clothing) are marked with your child's name.

DISCIPLINE: We have not found a large amount of discipline problems to be present over the years. If necessary, we stress positive forms of discipline which usually means a child must sit out of a particular activity and have a “time-out” for a period of time. Recurring problems will be discussed with parents.

HEALTH APPRAISAL SHEET (green form) and state mandated **CONTRACTS** must be on file before your child can attend. Health appraisals must be renewed annually.

TO ENROLL YOUR CHILD: Complete the “Application for Admission” and bring to the Day Care. We suggest you schedule a visit to the Day Care so you can observe our program. If you have any other questions we have not covered, please feel free to call us at (734) 697-7455.
